SCOPE: Laboratory and nursing staff involved with blood bank products.

PROCEDURE:

BLOOD RETURNED TO THE BLOOD BANK SHOULD NOT BE REISSUED FOR TRANSFUSION UNLESS THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE MET:

- 1. Blood has been out of a monitored refrigerator less than 30 minutes. Temperature must be maintained between 1 and 10 degrees Centigrade.
- 2. The blood unit has not been penetrated or entered in any manner. Sterility must be maintained.
- 3. The pilot tube, or sealed segments of integral donor tubing, has remained attached to the unit of blood.
- 4. Records indicate that the blood has been reissued and has been inspected prior to reissue. This is done through the Return Products in the computer. This will provide a permanent record of the unit disposition and subsequent return for re-issue.
