SCOPE: Histology staff.

PROCEDURE:

I. SAMPLE SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Fixative: 10% neutral-buffered formalin
- B. Volume: Specimen must be immersed in a volume 10 times that of the sample.
- C. Time Limitation: Must be placed in formalin within one hour of the procedure.
- D. Submitted to the laboratory with Tissue Examination Card (See LAB-SPC-09.02)

II. FRESH SAMPLE SUBMISSION TO HISTOLOGY

- A. Pathologist will evaluate the specimen and assess margins or special studies prior to immersion.
- B. All required specimen times will be recorded on the tissue card by the pathologist.
- C. Times will be recorded on the surgical report and submitted to reference lab.

III. SPECIFIC TEST IMMERSION REQUIREMENTS: CAP/ASCO guidelines

A. HER2:

- 1. Standard: Fixed between 6-48 hours prior to test submission
- 2. Fixation greater than 48 hours should automatically reflex to FISH testing.

B. ER/PgR:

- 1. Standard: Fixed between 6 72 hours prior to test submission
- 2. Fixation greater than 72 hours will automatically result in the reference lab attesting to the accuracy on the report.

IV. PATHOLOGIST RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ADEQUACY OF SUBMISSION

- A. Ensure times are recorded appropriately and transcribed on the surgical pathology report.
- B. Pursue response and corrective action for any samples submitted without adherence to proper submission protocols. (this includes reporting in the hospital SHARE system)
- C. Evaluate all hormone receptor testing results based on immersion interval documentation.
- V. **DOCUMENTATION OF ALL TIMED STANDARDS:** Surgical reports will include all time validations that appear on the Tissue Examination Card and will be a part of the Surgical Report.
